NYC D.O.B. approved Supported Scaffold Courses

4 HR User Supported Scaffold Safety Course

\$135.00 per person.

\$121.50 per person for groups of 10+

In compliance with Local Law 52, TSCTA offers the 4 HR User Supported Scaffold Training for any person who uses a supported scaffold of ANY. Per LL52, all workers must complete a training program of at least four-hours and be issued a supported scaffold user certificate verifying completion of the program in order to perform any work on a supported scaffold. In this course students will learn how to properly inspect and load scaffolds, prevent of fall and electrical hazards, Chapter 33 building regulations, ladder safety as well as a hands on demonstration that will show participants the proper way to wear a full body harness and much more. This certificate is valid for 4 years only. A 4 HR User Supported Scaffold Training must be completed every years to be able to perform any work on a supported scaffold. *Training is available in English, Spanish, Polish, Bengali and Hindi.*

32 HR Erector/Dismantler Supported Scaffold Safety Program

\$550.00 per person.

\$450.00 per person for groups of 6-9.

\$400 per person for groups of 10+

In compliance with Local Law 52, TSCTA offers the 32 HR Erector/Dismantler Supported Scaffold Training for any person who erects, dismantles, repairs, maintains or modifies supported scaffolding over 40 feet. In this course students will not only learn how to properly use a scaffold as well as erecting and dismantling, handling scaffolding components, Chapter 33 Building regulations, perform in hands on demonstrations of how to tie a variety of knots, how to wear a harness, and much more. Those in attendance of the 32 HR Training will be issued a supported scaffold user certificate verifying completion of the program. This certificate is valid for 4 years only. An eight-hour scaffold safety and training refresher program or course must be completed every four years. *Training is available in English, Spanish and Polish.*

8 HR Supported Scaffold Refresher Safety Program

\$200.00 per person.

\$180.00 per person for groups of 6-9.

\$160 per person for groups of 10+

In compliance with Local Law 52, TSCTA offers the NEW 8 HR Supported Scaffold Refresher for any individual who has previously completed a 32 HR Erector/Dismantler Supported Scaffold Training. The 32 HR Erector/Dismantler scaffold ID certifications are valid for 4 years only. Workers are required to complete a 8 HR Supported Scaffold Refresher in order to renew their license and continue erecting and/or dismantling supported scaffolding. *Training is available in English, Spanish and Polish.*

NYC D.O.B. approved Suspended Scaffold Courses

16 HR User Suspended Scaffold Safety Training

\$400.00 per person. \$360 per person for groups of 6-9. \$320 per person for groups of 10+

In compliance with the training requirements of Section 9-03, Rules of the City of NY, Section 9-03 pertaining to the use of all suspended scaffolds during construction, renovation or maintenance of a building exterior, TSCTA offers the 16 HR User Suspended Scaffold Training for any worker performing any of these tasks on a suspended scaffold. It is not applicable to pipe scaffolds, mast climbing work platforms, or any apparatus under the jurisdiction of the City's Elevator Division. In this course, workers will learn about proper assembly, maximum intended load, outrigger beams, tie-back and counterweights. They will learn how to use ropes and hoists, and how to prevent falls. Training also focuses on prevention of falling objects and how to use a personal fall arrest system. Any person who uses or operates suspended scaffolding must complete a training program of at least 16-hours that includes a written and practice examination. Passing course participants will be issued a full color, photo certificate of completion, which is valid for a period of four years. A refresher training course must be completed every four years to update the certificate for another four-year period. *Training is available in English, Spanish and Polish.*

32 HR Rigging/Foreman Suspended Scaffold Safety Training

\$600.00 per person. \$540 per person for groups of 6-9. \$480 per person for groups of 10+

Any worker whose job function is that of a licensed rigger or company designated rigging foreman must complete a DOB approved 32-Hour training program that includes both a written and practical examination. As required by the DOB, the class and course exam is available in English only. This course will cover Chapter 33 Building Codes, Rigging Rule #9 and other topics such as fall protection, how to supervise a jobsite, how to recognize and fix hazards, how to work on a suspended scaffold and a hands on demonstration showing students the proper usage of harness, how to tie knots and much more. Passing course participants will be issued a full color, photo certificate of completion, which is valid for a period of four years. A refresher-training course must be completed every four years to update the certificate for another four-year period. *Training is available in English ONLY.*

OSHA Courses

10 Hour OSHA Health & Safety Training

\$200.00 per person.

\$180 per person for groups of 10+

This safety course was developed by the US Department of Labor to provide construction workers, supervisors, and other personnel responsible for construction activities with an awareness of construction safety and health concerns in the construction industry. Attendees discuss and review standard construction safety and health principles, and receive information that will prepare them to recognize and control a variety of hazardous conditions. Training is available in English and Spanish. Included with course fee is the Official JJ Keller OSHA Construction Safety Handbook. As required by the NYS Department of Labor (Local Law 20), for any public work construction contract (state agencies, municipalities, school districts) valued at more than \$250,000, all onsite laborers, workers, and mechanics are to complete a minimal of 10 hours of OSHA Training. This course is also required under Local Law 41 of 2008, for any employee who will be working on a "major building" (as defined by 2008 Building Code). This course is also required for individuals applying as a Site Safety Manager, Site Safety Coordinator and/or Superintendent, based upon the applicant's qualifications. All participants will receive certificate of completion from TSC and laminated 10-HR Construction Safety Outreach course card directly from OSHA. *Training is available in English, Spanish, Polish, Bengal and Hindi.*

30 Hour OSHA Health & Safety Training

This program examines OSHA policies, procedures, and standards, as well as construction safety and health principles. The training emphasizes those areas that are most hazardous, using OSHA standards as a guide. Program is more applicable for the construction supervisor, with a more intensified focus on various occupational safety and health standards. Course participants can expect to be able to locate and identify OSHA standards in 29 CFR 1926; identify common causes of accidents and fatalities in hazardous areas of construction; recommend abatement techniques for such hazards; and recognize various construction processes, materials and equipment. This course is also required for individuals applying as a Site Safety Manager, Site Safety Coordinator and/or Superintendent, based upon the applicant's qualifications. Included with the course fee is CFR 1926 OSHA Construction Industry Regulations manual. All participants will receive certificate of completion from TSC and laminated 30-HR Construction Safety Outreach course card directly from OSHA. *Training is available in English and Spanish.*

Site Safety Manager Courses

40 Hour Site Safety Manager Program

\$850.00 price per person. \$765 per person for groups of 6-9. \$680 per person for groups of 10+.*

In compliance with NYC Local Law 59, a Site Safety Manager is required to be present on site for projects that are 14 stories or more. Our knowledgeable instructors, the majority of which are themselves licensed site safety managers, will walk you through the entire process of applying as a Site Safety Manager, from how to prepare your paperwork to how to prepare for the actual exam. The course focuses on safety requirements of Article 19 of Title C of the Administrative Code Safety of Public and Property During Construction Operations. Topics such as excavation, erection, alteration, repair, removal and demolition as it relates to rules and regulations governing safety at construction sites in NYC are also addressed. As of 2008, Rule 48 requires that all new buildings and demolition projects up to an including 9 stories will need to be supervised by a registered **Construction Superintendent**. Carpenters, masons or building inspectors must complete the 40 HR Course to satisfy the education requirements required by the NYC DOB to register as a Construction Superintendent. This course is also required for individuals who are applying as a Site Safety Coordinator, based upon the applicant's qualifications. SSCs are required to be present on site for projects that are 10-14 stories. Included with course fee is the Chapter 33 manual, multiple hand outs including Candidate Information Bulletin and many more. Upon completion of the course participants will receive a certificate of completion.

7 Hour Site Safety Managers Orientation Program

\$295.00 per person. \$265 per person for groups of 10+

This course is ideal for qualified construction professionals, NYS Licensed Professional Engineers or NYS Registered Architects **ONLY** interested in qualifying for the Site Safety Manager License Examination. Proof of professional standing must be supplied with initial Site Safety Manager Exam Application. This course is also required for individuals applying as a Site Safety Manager, Site Safety Coordinator or Construction Superintendent, based upon the applicant's qualifications. Included with course fee is the Chapter 33, NYC DOB Building Code manual. Upon completion of the course participants will receive a certificate of completion.

7 Hour Site Safety Managers Refresher Program

\$245.00 Per Person \$220.50 per person for groups of 10+*

This Refresher program is an all inclusive program that allows you to complete the 7 hours of continuing education required every 3 years to renew your Site Safety Managers license. TSCTA will help refresh your knowledge of the Chapter 33 Building Codes, as well as prepare AND submit your renewal application. Included with course fee is the Chapter 33, NYC DOB Building Code manual. Upon completion of the course participants will receive a certificate of completion.

Newly Added Courses

30 HR Concrete Safety Manager Program

\$500.00 per person. \$450 per person for groups of 6-9 \$400 per person for groups of 10+

As of July 15, 2010, the Department of Buildings requires a Concrete Safety Manager to be present on major building construction projects that involve the placement of 2,000 cubic yards or more of concrete. No person is permitted to perform any concrete safety manager duties without being registered with the NYC Department of Buildings. As part of one of the requirements set forth by the NYC DOB, each applying candidate must have completed a **30-HR Concrete Safety Manager Training** (in addition to a 10 HR OSHA Safety & Health Outreach Training - also provided by TSC TA) prior to filing for registration. This program will provide participants with a clear understanding of the roles of a Concrete Safety Manager such as recordkeeping, supervising project site and accident prevention as well as how to register with the NYC DOB. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a full color, waterproof picture ID card and a Course Completion Certificate, each with its own individual assigned number to prove its authenticity.

30 HR Tower/Crane Rigging Program

\$500.00 per person. \$450 per person for groups of 6-9 \$400 per person for groups of 10+

In compliance with Local Law 44 of 2008, TSCTA offers the 30 HR Tower/Crane Rigging Program which is required for all workers engaged in the erection, jumping, climbing, rigging, or dismantling of a limber or tower crane, including licensed rigger and rigging foreman. Due to the high volume of accidents that occurred with tower cranes since 2005, the NYC DOB implemented Local Law 44 and has enforced it since April 2010 to ensure that all workers, riggers, and crane operators are knowledgeable on crane safety and accident prevention. The 30-hr HR Tower Crane Rigging Training will teach all crane operators, licensed riggers, rigger foremen, and workers how to follow instructions on fall protection, crane assembly/disassembly, crane operator communication, how to prevent accidents with cranes and hoists, how to inspect cranes and much more. The course certificate will be valid for 3 years from the date of issuance, and will have to be renewed with an 8-hour refresher course. Upon completion of the course, students will receive a full color, waterproof picture ID card and a Course Completion Certificate, each with its own individual assigned number to prove its authenticity.

HAZWOPER Courses

40 HR Hazardous Waste Operations & Emergency Response Standard (HAZWOPER)

\$645.00 per person. \$58.50 per person for groups of 6-9. \$516 per person for groups of 10+

TSCTA's 40-HR HAZWOPER training course is designed to teach attendees who enter sites that contain potentially hazardous waste basic health & safety work practices necessary to confidently work with and around hazardous materials and waste. Designed in accordance with OSHA requirements under 29 CFR 1910.120, this training is intended to meet the requirements of introductory, general training which, must then be followed by on-the-job site specific operating procedures for use of personal protective equipment (PPE), decontamination methods and other procedures. Students will receive Comprehensive, nine-chapter hard cover course manual that contains abundance of facts for persons who are or who anticipate being employed at a hazardous waste worksite. Can be retained and used after training as informative guide of potential worksite hazards and recognition, control and treatment of such hazards. Upon conclusion of the training students will receive a course completion for HAZWOPER training under 29 CFR 1910.12.

8 HR Hazardous Waste Operations & Emergency Response Refresher

\$175.00 per person. \$157.50 per person for groups of 10+

TSCTA offers this one-day ANNUAL refresher course required on an annual basis to extend accreditation conferred after completion of initial 40-Hour HAZWOPER program. This training will refresh the participant's knowledge of on-the-job specific operation procedures such as handling hazardous waste, how to properly use personal protective equipment (PPE) and much more. Upon conclusion of the training students will receive a course completion for HAZWOPER training under 29 CFR 1910.12.

D.O.H approved Safety Courses

Asbestos Abatement Worker/Handler-Initial Training

\$400.00 per person.

This 32-hour program is applicable for abatement workers, as required by NYC and NYS, who within work area, remove, encapsulates, handles or disturbs friable asbestos, which may result in release of asbestos fiber. Training is designed to give each student a thorough understanding of the different removal processes as well as importance of public protection and potential health effects. Participants who complete this 32-hour training are required to take an 8-hour Refresher course annually to maintain their certification. These trainings are approved by the Department of Health. Upon completion of course, attendees will receive an course completion certificate.

Asbestos Abatement Worker/Handler-Refresher

\$125.00 per person

TSCA's Asbestos Abatement Worker/Handler Refresher is an 8-hour course that is required for all certified asbestos workers to extend their accreditation for a period of one year. Training consists of a review of federal and state regulations, engineering controls and decontamination systems. Training will also cover the renewal process for which attendees will have to complete to renew their certification. Students will receive user Manuals containing images and important facts covered in training, which will provide essential knowledge of asbestos awareness for anyone working in the construction industry. Upon completion of course, attendees will receive an course completion certificate.

Asbestos Abatement Contractor/Supervisor-Initial Training

\$500.00 per person

TSCA's Asbestos Abatement Contractor/Supervisor-Initial Training is a 40 hour training program includes the full 32-hour asbestos abatement worker/handler initial program, as well as 8 additional course hours specific to accredit those individuals who provide supervision and direction to workers engaged in asbestos abatement activities and/or individuals who operate an abatement business. Topics include supervisory techniques, insurance and liability considerations, PPE, and overview of federal and state regulations. Upon completion of course, attendees will receive an course completion certificate.

D.O.H approved Safety Courses *(continued)*

Asbestos Abatement Contractor/Supervisor-Refresher

\$125.00 per person

This one-day refresher course required for all certified asbestos contractor/supervisors for reaccreditation for a one-year period. The eight-hours of training includes review of relevant legislature and applicable agencies that enforce laws, supervisory techniques, and air monitoring. Upon completion of course, attendees will receive an course completion certificate.

Allied Trades Initial Training

\$275 per participant

This program, accredited by the New York State Department of Health under approval from the United States Environmental Protection Agency, is 12 hours in length. The training is applicable for any individual (s) performing limited or special tasks in preparation of or ancillary to an asbestos abatement project or one engaged in a similar occupation. Those who complete an accredited New York State Health Department asbestos certification training program are eligible to apply to the New York State Department of Labor for an asbestos Allied Trades certificate, specific to the abatement activities they intend to conduct. To maintain the certification, an annual 4-hour refresher course is required. Upon completion of course, attendees will receive an course completion certificate.

Allied Trades Refresher

\$125 per participant

This 4-hour refresher course is required annually for recertification of the Initial Allied Trades license. This training will refresh the participant's knowledge of the proper procedures of abatement activities and much more. Upon completion of course, attendees will receive an course completion certificate.

Confined Space Awareness Seminar

TSCTA offers the Confined Space Awareness Seminar which is a requirement for employees performing work in hazardous areas. Topics of discussion include acceptable entry conditions, proper equipment, rescue requirements and much more. Upon completion of the course, attendees will receive an awareness certificate.

Confined Space Permit Entry Seminar

This Confined Space Permit Entry Seminar will teach students the OSHA requirements for confined space entry, hazard identification, atmospheric testing considerations, basic ventilation principles, and use of Permit Entry System.
